How to find St. Frances Cabrini

Address: 1500 Franklin Avenue SE Minneapolis, MN 55414

FROM 35W SOUTHBOUND

- 1) Head southwest on I-35W S
- 2) Keep right to take I-35W S via exit 127 toward Minneapolis
- 3) Merge onto MN 280 S via exit 23A.
- 4) Exit at the Territorial Rd/University Ave.
- 5) Go to the 3rd stop light. (The first light is Territorial Rd, the second light is University Ave & the 3rd is Franklin)
- 6) Turn right onto Franklin Ave.
- 7) Go about 3/4 mile. Church is on the left.

FROM 35W NORTHBOUND:

- 1) Take exit 16B to merge onto I-94 E toward St Paul
- 2) Take exit 235A toward 25th Ave/Riverside Ave
- 3) Merge onto 9th St S
- 4) Slight right at Riverside Ave
- 5) Slight left at E Franklin Ave
- 6) Follow Franklin across the Franklin Ave bridge
- 6) At the end of the bridge, take an "easy right" to SE Franklin Ave (At the end of the bridge is a 5 corner intersection. Continuing straight ahead from the bridge will put you onto 27th Ave. Making a sharp right or left will put you on the River Road.)
- 7) Go 2 blocks. The church is on the right.

FROM 94 WESTBOUND:

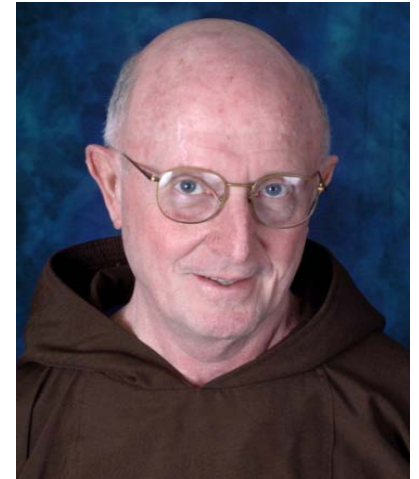
- 1) Head west on I-94 W
- 2) Take the 280 exit toward University Ave
- 3) Go to the first stop light
- 4) Turn left at Franklin Ave
- 5) Go about 3/4 mile. Church is on the left.

FROM 35W EASTBOUND:

- 1) Head east on I-94 W
- 2) Keep right to take Exit 235A toward 25th Avenue/Riverside Avenue.
- 3) Stay straight to go onto 9th St S
- 4) Slight right at Riverside Ave
- 5) Slight left at E Franklin Ave
- 6) Follow Franklin across the Franklin Ave bridge
- 6) At the end of the bridge, take an "easy right" to SE Franklin Ave (At the end of the bridge is a 5 corner intersection. Continuing straight ahead from the bridge will put you onto 27th Ave. Making a sharp right or left will put you on the River Road.)
- 7) Go 2 blocks. The church is on the right.

<p>Michael Crosby is a Capuchin Franciscan. He lives in community with other friars in a downtown Milwaukee parish that serves the urban poor, homeless and marginated. His own ministry revolves around his attempt to proclaim the gospel of God's Trinitarian reign and the conversion that is needed to bring about Trinitarian relationships of equality at all levels "on earth as it is in heaven." Specifically it attempts to help develop a spirituality of discipleship for U.S. and other "First World" Catholics.</p> <p>Since 1973 Michael has been a pioneer among Catholics in promoting corporate reform through socially responsible investing. He was influential in getting Catholics to work with the Protestant and Jewish communities in this effort at the Interfaith Center on Corporate Responsibility (ICCR). He has been very involved in a wide range of issues--from South Africa and infant formula to global warming and tobacco control. He coordinates the work of religious institutions in the Wisconsin, Iowa and Minnesota, Dakotas (WIM/CRI) who are part of the ICCR.</p> <p>Michael's preaching and writing on contemporary biblical discipleship has taken him around the world. Toward this end he gives retreats, workshops and parish missions. He has written seventeen books. All of his latest books have received awards from the Catholic Press Association of Canada and the United States, including a First Place for his <i>Can Religious Life Be Prophetic?</i> His latest books are: <i>Finding Francis</i>, <i>Following Christ</i> (Orbis;2007) and <i>The Paradox of Power: Moving from Control to Compassion in a Violent World</i> (Crossroads:2008). Now it has moved into a full-fledged program being used by individuals, groups and organizations both in secular and faith-based environments. Building on basic elements from physics about energy and Jesus' proclamation of the "Energy" of God's Reign, he will show that all human relationships can be found on a grid that reinforces negative or positive dynamics of power.
