One of three whistleblowers chosen as persons of the year by **TIME** magazine, **Coleen Rowley** served as a special agent with the FBI in Minneapolis. Following the September 11, 2001, attacks, Rowley testified in front of the Senate and 9/11 Commission about the FBI's internal organization and mishandling of information, and documented how FBI HQ personnel in Washington, D.C., had failed to take action on information provided by the Minneapolis, Minnesota Field Office regarding its investigation of suspected terrorist Zacarias Maussaoui.

Rowley has authored a chapter of civil liberties in a book published by the Milton Eisenhower Foundation entitled, *Patriotism, Democracy and Common Sense: Restoring America's Promise at Home and Abroad*. She also ran unsuccessfully for U.S. Congress in Minnesota's Second Congressional District in 2006. Coleen has been married to Ross Rowley for 31 years and they have three daughters, one son and two grandchildren.
